



Endurance Selectors for 2011-2012

This memo serves as a call to those interested in serving as a Selector for the 2011-2012 Endurance competition years to contact me in writing, or by email, on or before 30 April 2011.

Qualifications:

Selectors will be members of the Endurance community who are knowledgeable and experienced in Endurance riding at the International level. Selectors must be senior members of United States Equestrian Federation (USEF) in good standing, and should also be members in good standing of American Endurance Ride Conference (AERC). Selectors must be able to make decisions that are in the best interest of our sport and to the USA team effort at the International High Performance (IHP) level. In that regard, selectors will be subject to the Code of Conduct, the Code of Ethics and Conflict of Interest Policy of USEF.

There will be two (2) selectors named plus a Chairperson. Of these, at least one (1) must be an active athlete. At least one alternate selector will also be named. An alternate selector will take the place of a selector who has a conflict of interest, or a substantial appearance of a conflict of interest. Athletes or owners who may apply for selection to a team in 2011 or 2012 should not serve as selectors. Endurance Selectors also serve as members of the Endurance Credentials Committee.

Once obtained, the list of selector nominees will be considered by the USEF Eligible Athletes Committee, which will recommend ten (10) names to the USEF IHP Committee as potential selectors. The IHP Committee will then nominate two (2) selectors, a Selection Chair and alternates from that list to the USEF Executive Committee for approval.

Duties

Our expectations are that you will not be required to attend Selection (Ranking) Trials for 2011. You will be expected to conduct a paper review and to take part in conference calls as required by my office or the Selection Chair. In 2012, you will be required to attend approximately two Selection Trials. The Team Staff and I will be making recommendations to the IHP Committee regarding your further duties during your term as selectors.
