This Level 1 course is being offered to USEF Endurance Officials, competitors, and others experienced in Endurance who have an interest in becoming an FEI Endurance Judge or Steward *and* 2* FEI Endurance Judges and Stewards for license maintenance. 3* and 4* FEI Endurance Officials may audit the course for information purposes only (no continuing education credit).

The course includes classroom instruction along with an opportunity for hands-on apprenticing at the Kentucky Cup CEI3*/2* & North American Endurance Team Challenge, being held October 13-14, 2009 at the Kentucky Horse Park in Lexington, KY. This is a test event for the Alltech FEI 2010 World Equestrian Games.

Lexington Bluegrass Airport (LEX)

Cincinnati/Northern Kentucky International (CVG) – 75 miles from Lexington

Louisville International (SDF) – 75 miles from Lexington

DIRECTIONS TO USEF

From Bluegrass Airport- exit airport left onto Man O' War Blvd, turn right on Versailles Rd, take ramp onto New Circle Rd North, take Exit 9 Newtown Pk, turn left on Iron Works Pk (4-way stop), use KY Horse Park main entrance (past the campground entrance). Bear right out of the roundabout and proceed until the road turns left. USEF is the second building on the right with the flags. Please park in the parking area directly across from building.

From North (Cincinnati) - take I-75 South to Exit 120 Iron Works Pk, turn left and use KY Horse Park main entrance on your left. Follow directions above.

From West (Louisville) - take I-64 East to I-75 North to Exit 120 Iron Works Pike. Turn right and use the KY Horse Park main entrance on your left. Follow directions above

From Four Points Sheraton - turn right on to Newtown Pk from Stanton Way, go 2 miles and turn left on Iron Works Pike (4-way stop), use KY Horse Park main entrance. Follow directions above.
