- All ride sanction applications MUST be approved by the Sanctioning Director in the region where the ride will be held.
- Sanction applications must be submitted to the Sanctioning Director at least 120 days prior to the requested ride date. Approved applications must reach the AERC office no later than 90 days prior to the ride date. Please note: special sanction requests require additional time and may require board approval.
- Elevator rides must be indicated on application.
- Limited distance rides, held in conjunction with sanctioned endurance rides, must be sanctioned.
- Fun rides, or rides less than 25 miles, held in conjunction with sanctioned endurance rides, must be listed on this form.
- Appropriate application fees must be submitted with application and are nonrefundable.
